### Increase Your Odds

Be Prepared for Severe Storms

Severe storms are more common in the spring and summer, but they can occur any time of year. Make sure you are prepared for a storm and know how to stay safe

Assemble a kit of essentials, like water, battery-operated flashlights and radios. Keep a list of emergency phone numbers that includes Carbon Power & Light. Be prepared for the possibility of a prolonged outage due to power line and electric equipment damage.

During an outage, switch off lights and appliances to prevent overloading circuits and damaging appliances when power is restored. Leave one lamp or switch on as a signal for when your power returns.

If severe weather is on its way, pay attention to local weather reports and recommendations. A tornado or severe storm watch means that conditions are favorable for those weather conditions forming. A warning means that dangerous weather conditions are developing and imminent.

Lightning can travel up to ten miles away from a storm, so seek shelter as soon as you hear thunder.

If caught outside, stay away from downed power lines and be alert to the possibility that tree limbs or debris may hide an electrical hazard. Assume that any dangling wires you encounter are energized and dangerous. Warn others to stay away and contact Carbon.

If you are driving and come upon a downed power line, stay in your vehicle, warn others to stay away and contact emergency personnel or Carbon. Also when driving, be careful at intersections where traffic lights may be out. Stop at all railroad crossings, and treat road intersections with traffic signals as a four-way stop before proceeding with caution.

Before re-entering storm-damaged buildings or rooms, be sure all electric and gas services are turned off. Never attempt to turn off power at the breaker box if you must stand in water to do so. If you can't reach your breaker box safely, call Carbon to shut off power at the meter.

Never step into a flooded basement or other area if water is covering electrical outlets, appliances or cords. Be alert to any electrical equipment that could be energized and in contact with water. Never touch electrical appliances, cords or wires while you are wet or standing in water.
